AMERICAN FAMILY ALBUM



You Will Need:

- Album page*
- 3 Colored background sheets*
- #2 Pencil
- Ruler
- Photo-safe glue stick
- Photograph (copy)*
- Scissors or craft knife
- 4 Coordinating solid-colored papers*
- Gold photo corners (optional)*
- Sheet protector

Instructions

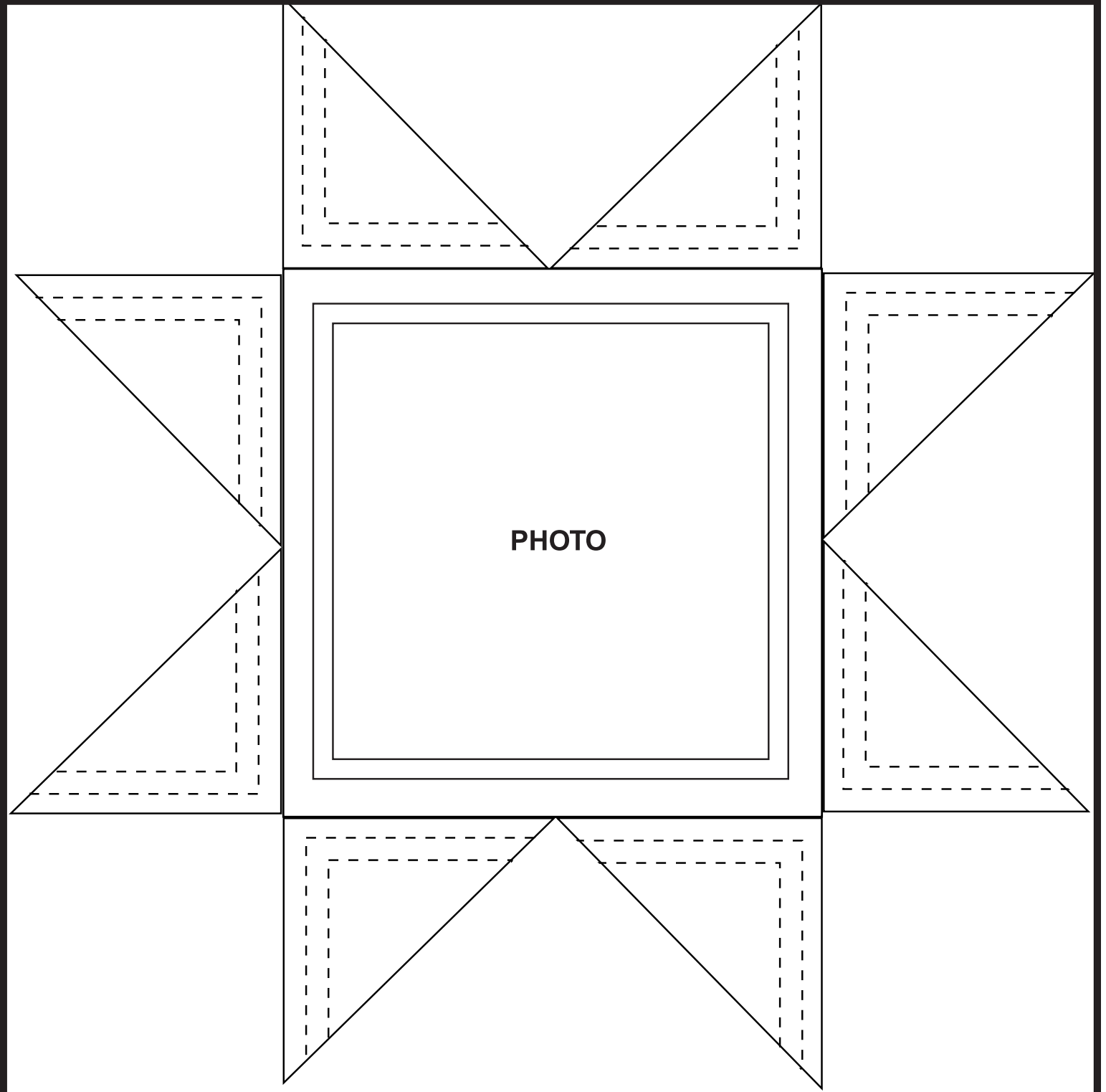
1. Use a photocopier to enlarge this pattern to fit your album page.
2. Using the pattern pieces provided:
 - Cut 4 each of pieces 1, 2, & 3
 - Cut 1 of piece 4
 - Trim your photo to piece 5
3. Make 4 stacks of squares: Glue 1 each of pieces 1, 2, & 3 in a stack with smallest on top and largest on the bottom. Be sure to center them carefully atop each other.
4. Cut each stack in half diagonally, creating 8 triangles.
5. Measure 3 background squares: The first should fit just inside your scrapbook page (but be sure it's square and NOT rectangular.) The second should be slightly smaller than the first, and the last should be the smallest.
6. Center and glue the three background sheets on top of each other with the smallest of top, and the largest on bottom.
7. Adhere your photo to piece 4 and glue it down (or use photo corners) into the center of the background stack you made in step 6.
8. Arrange the triangle pieces as shown in the example and glue down.
9. Make a "title" piece from the same paper as piece 4, and write the title or caption of your photo. Glue it below the photo.
10. Adhere background sheet to album page.
11. Insert your finished page into your sheet protector. Now you're ready to place it in your album!

* Acid-free products are recommended.
