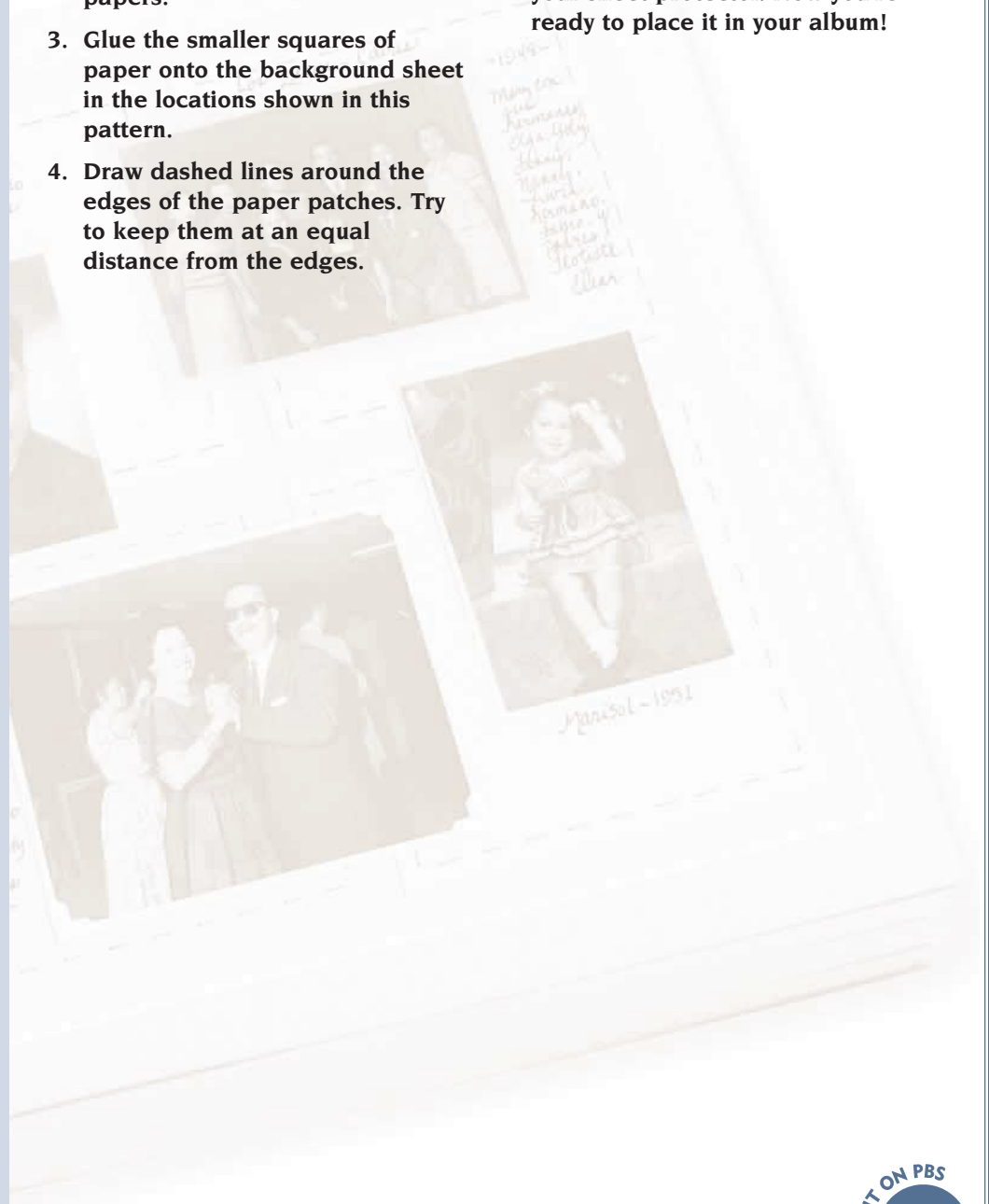


## You Will Need:

- Album page\*
- Colored background sheet\*
- #2 Pencil
- Ruler
- Photo-safe glue stick
- Photographs (copies)\*
- Scissors or craft knife
- 5 Coordinating solid-colored papers\*
- White photo corners (optional)\*
- Sheet protector

## Instructions

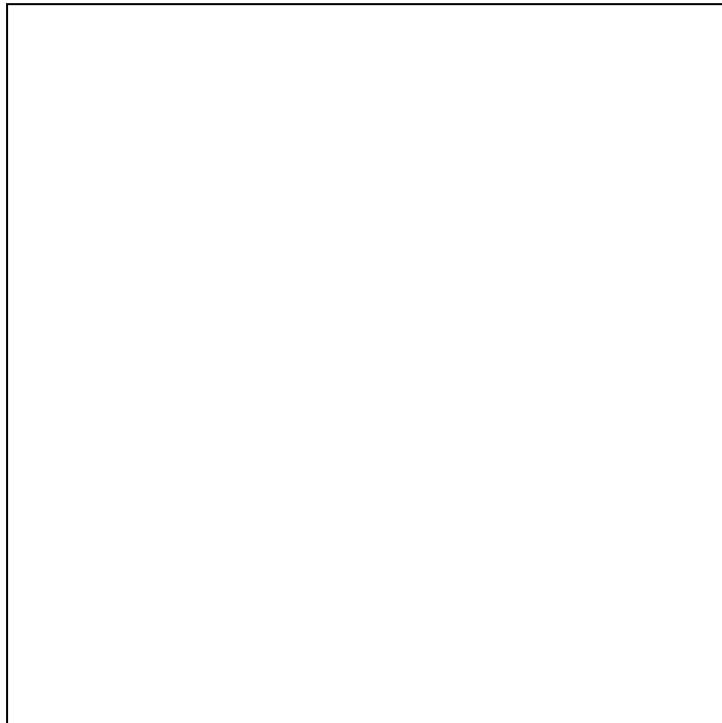
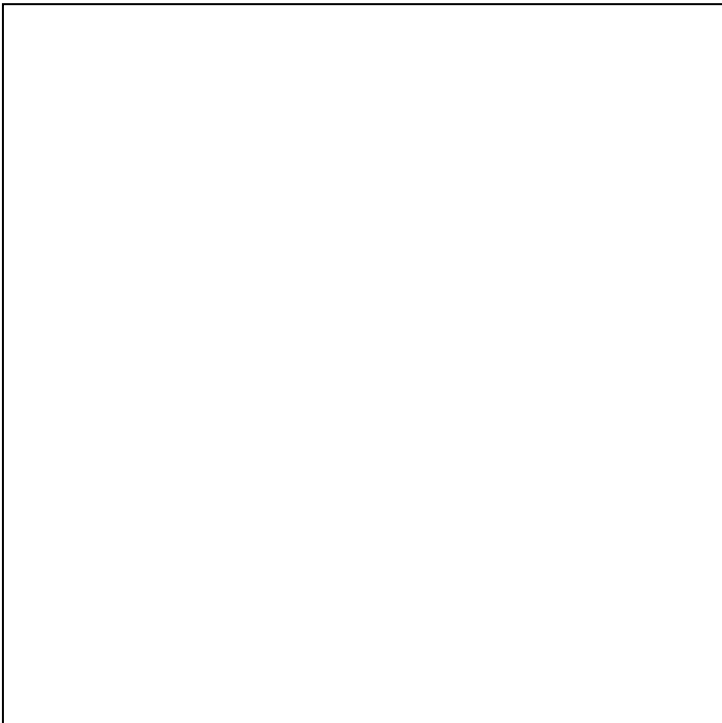
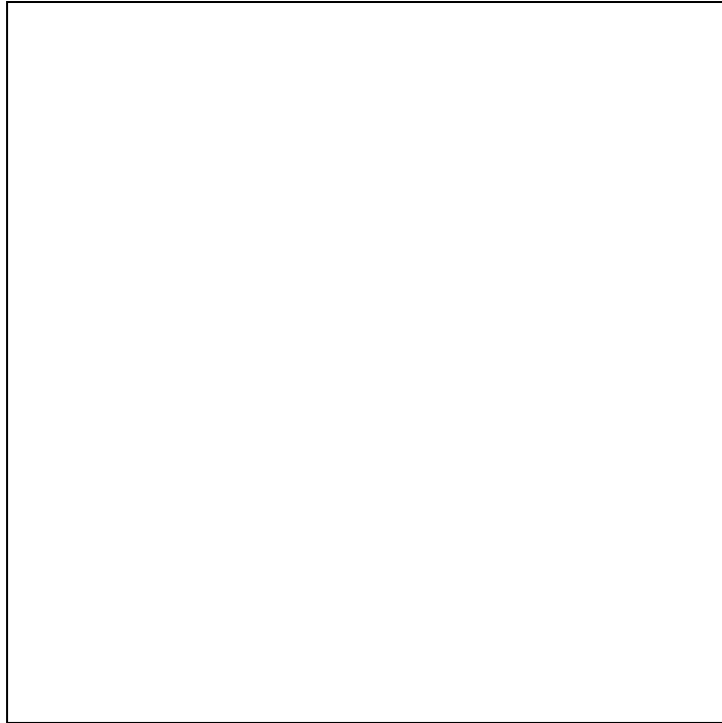
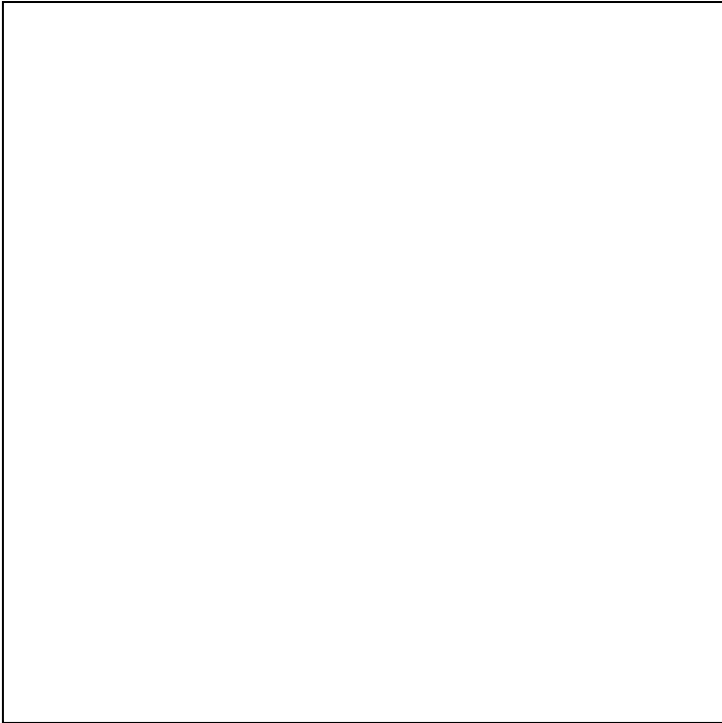
1. Use a photocopier to enlarge this pattern to fit your album page or follow the transfer directions given in the main document.
2. Use pattern piece 1 to cut your background sheet. Use pattern piece 2 to cut four squares from coordinating solid-colored papers.
3. Glue the smaller squares of paper onto the background sheet in the locations shown in this pattern.
4. Draw dashed lines around the edges of the paper patches. Try to keep them at an equal distance from the edges.
5. Size and mount your photographs, using white photo corners, if desired.
6. Add your journaling/captions.
7. Adhere background sheet to album page.
8. Insert your finished page into your sheet protector. Now you're ready to place it in your album!
