Kaleidoscope





You Will Need:

- Album page*
- Colored background sheet*
- #2 Pencil
- Ruler
- Photo-safe glue stick
- 8 Photographs (copies)*
- Scissors or craft knife
- 2 Coordinating solid-colored papers*
- Sheet protector

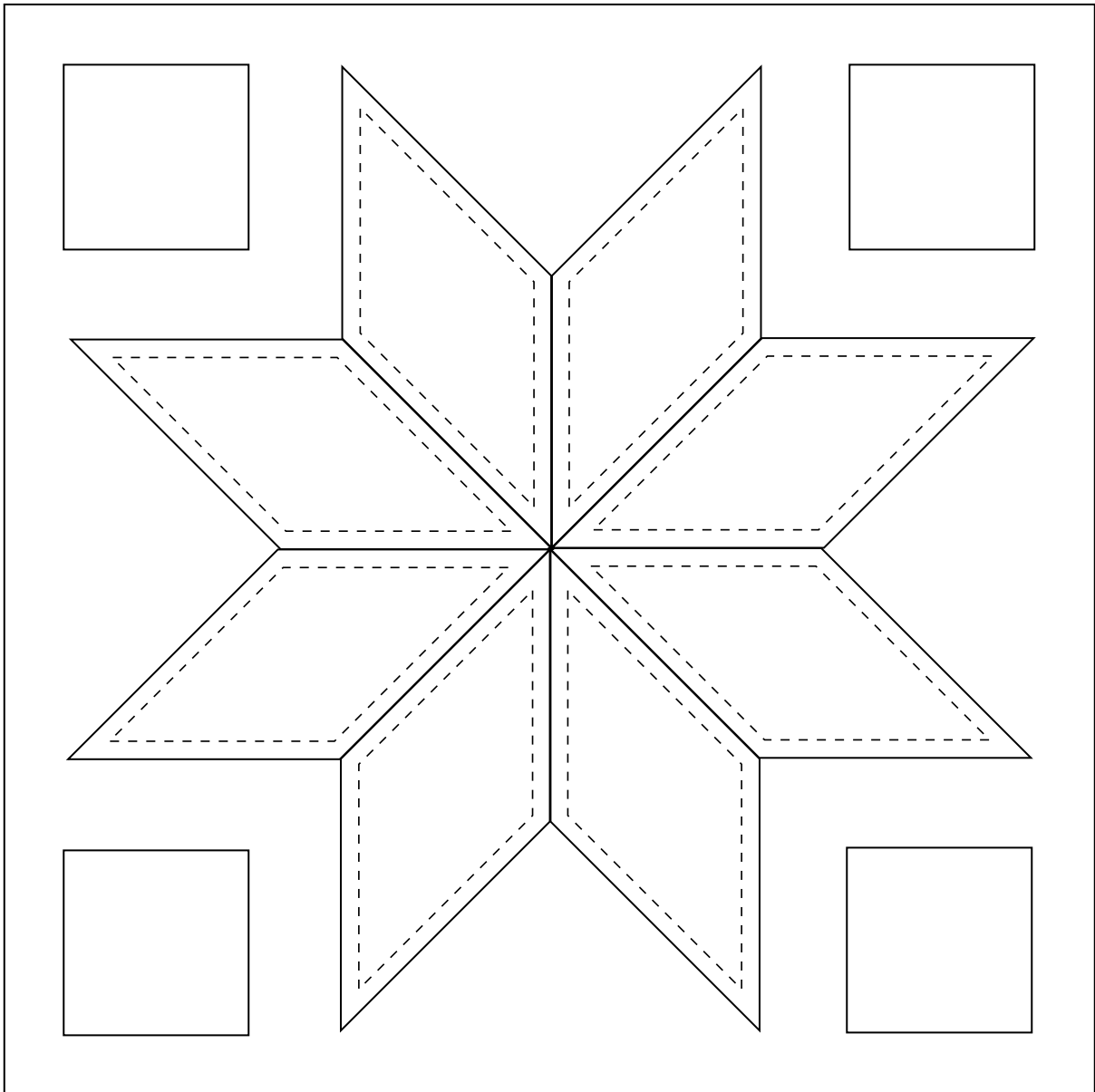
Instructions

1. Use a photocopier to enlarge this pattern to fit your album page or follow the transfer directions given in the main document.
2. Cut your background sheet to fit your album page.
3. From one solid color paper, cut a square using pattern piece 4. Center and glue it on the background page.
4. From the other solid color paper, cut 4 each of pieces 2a, 2b & 3.
5. Use pattern pieces 1a & 1b to size your photos. As you crop them be sure they rotate around the center of the star. (The bottom of each photo will face the center of the star.)
6. Arrange the diamond-shaped pieces from step 4 before gluing. Arrange your photos on top of the diamond-shaped pieces to be sure you have them in the order you want and that they all fit properly. Be careful: pieces 1a and 1b look alike, but are slightly different in shape. (Photo 1a should be placed on 2a; photo 1b should be placed on 2b.)
7. With your pencil, lightly mark the position of the diamonds on the background, and glue your photos to them. Then glue the diamonds to the background.
8. Glue the 4 squares into the corners as shown in the pattern.
9. Add journaling or captions if desired.
10. Adhere background sheet to album page.
11. Insert your finished page into your sheet protector. Now you're ready to place it in your album!

* Acid-free products are recommended.
