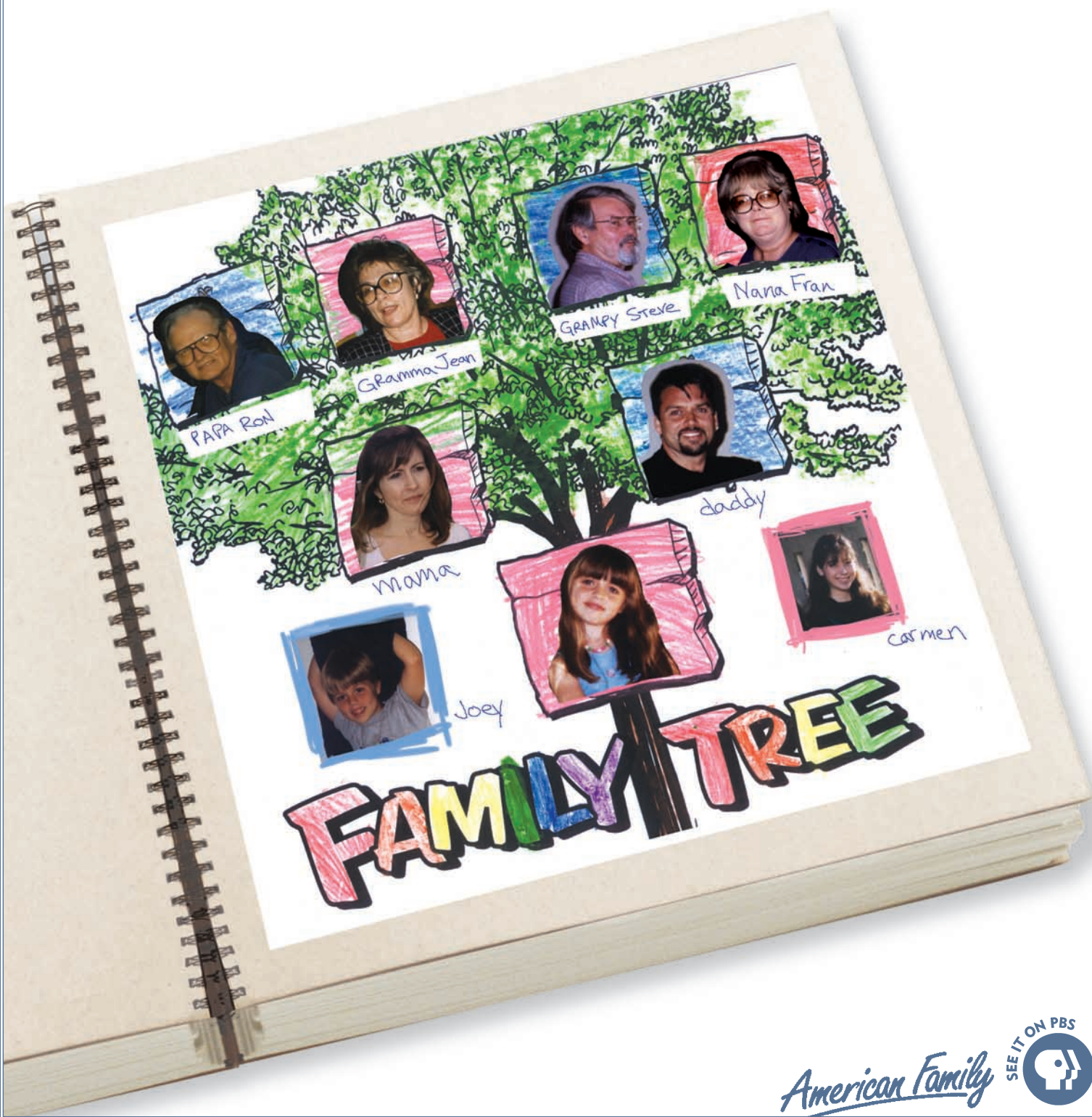

You Will Need:

- Album page*
- Crayons, colored pencils or markers
- Photo-safe glue stick
- 7 or more photographs (copies)*
- Scissors
- Sheet protector

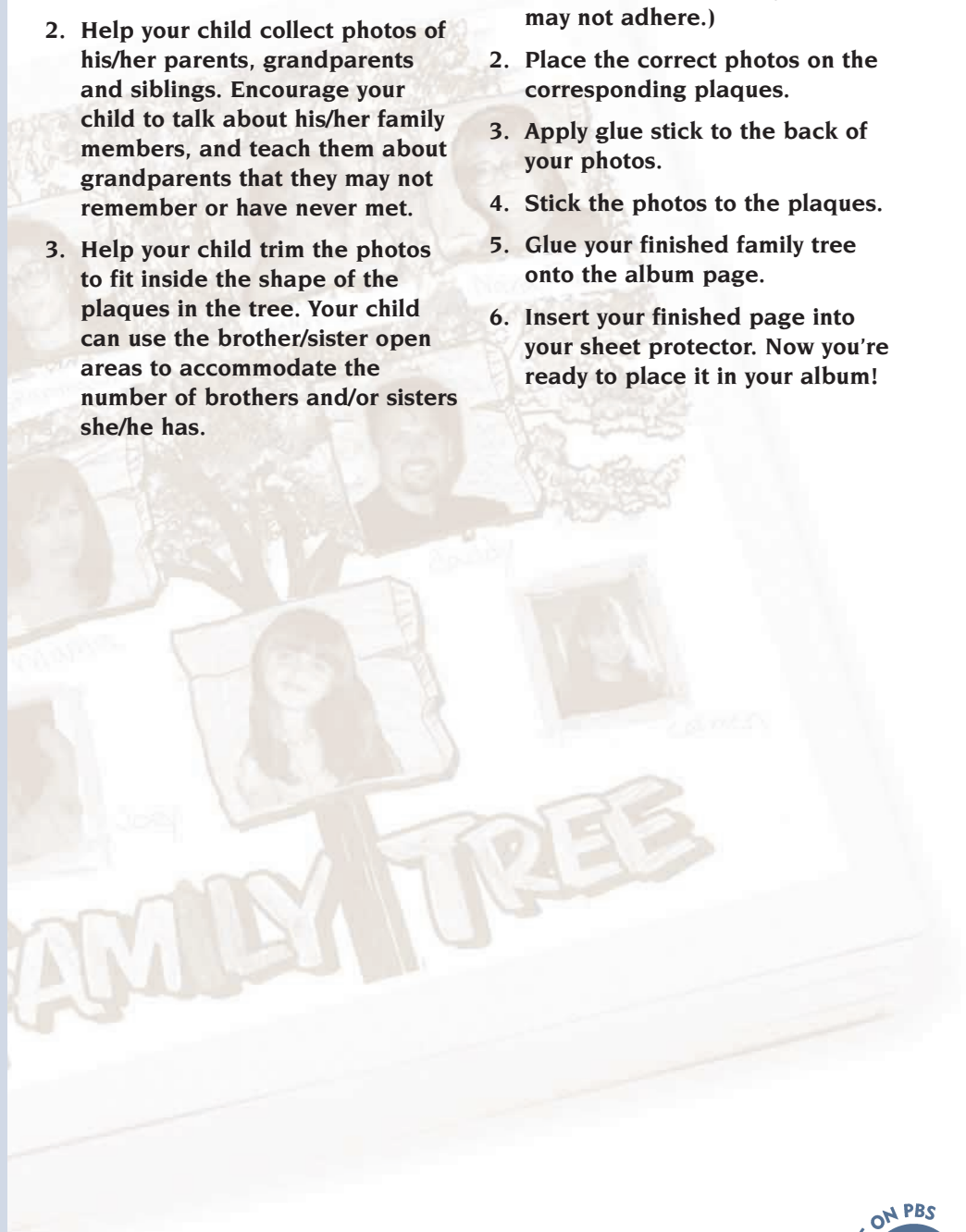
Instructions

PARENT'S DIRECTIONS:

1. Use a photocopier to enlarge this coloring page to fit your album page. Your child will color this page and glue his/her photos to the spaces indicated. No other papers are needed.
2. Help your child collect photos of his/her parents, grandparents and siblings. Encourage your child to talk about his/her family members, and teach them about grandparents that they may not remember or have never met.
3. Help your child trim the photos to fit inside the shape of the plaques in the tree. Your child can use the brother/sister open areas to accommodate the number of brothers and/or sisters she/he has.

CHILD'S DIRECTIONS:

1. Using crayons, markers or colored pencils, color the tree, "Family Tree" title and plaques. (If using crayons or colored pencils, do not color the center of the plaques as the glue stick may not adhere.)
2. Place the correct photos on the corresponding plaques.
3. Apply glue stick to the back of your photos.
4. Stick the photos to the plaques.
5. Glue your finished family tree onto the album page.
6. Insert your finished page into your sheet protector. Now you're ready to place it in your album!
