

Sample Criteria Sheet

- Each group will develop a multimedia presentation on a foreign-born artist or “creator.”
- The presentation **MUST** run at least four minutes in length, including slide timings and transitions.
- The final presentation **MUST** include the following:
- A title slide with the full names of each group member, along with the class period and name of the class.
- At least four sound files, either from Power Point or from a “.wav” sound file. If your group is creating a presentation on a composer, one of the sound files should be an excerpt from a musical work from that composer.
- At least five pictures should be included in the presentation, along with a picture of the subject on the title slide.
- Each presentation must include specific biographical information about the subject, including your view of how the artist/creator impacted American society and the arts, as well as information about their career in their home country.
- At the end of the presentation, the group must include a bibliography slide listing all the sources the group used for their presentation, including pictures and sound files used. The group should also submit their completed information collection sheet for grading.
