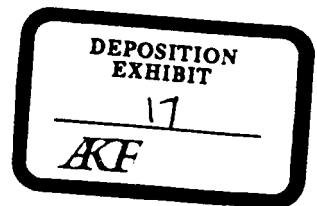



In reviewing our copy of the above identified agreement which a Dow representative presented to you at a meeting on November 14, 1972, I note we failed to properly date the execution of the document. The agreement was signed on behalf of Dow on November 13, 1972 and you may enter this date below the signature if you so desire.

Two other minor points. Mr. M. F. Pruitt is Director of Research for Dow U.S.A., an operating company of The Dow Chemical Company, and not a vice president of Dow as identified in the agreement. He is however fully authorized to sign on behalf of Dow. Secondly, the word "formally" is misspelled in line 7 of the body of the agreement.

We did not feel that these informalities made in our haste to have the agreement ready for the HCA were of such a nature to warrant execution of a new agreement.
