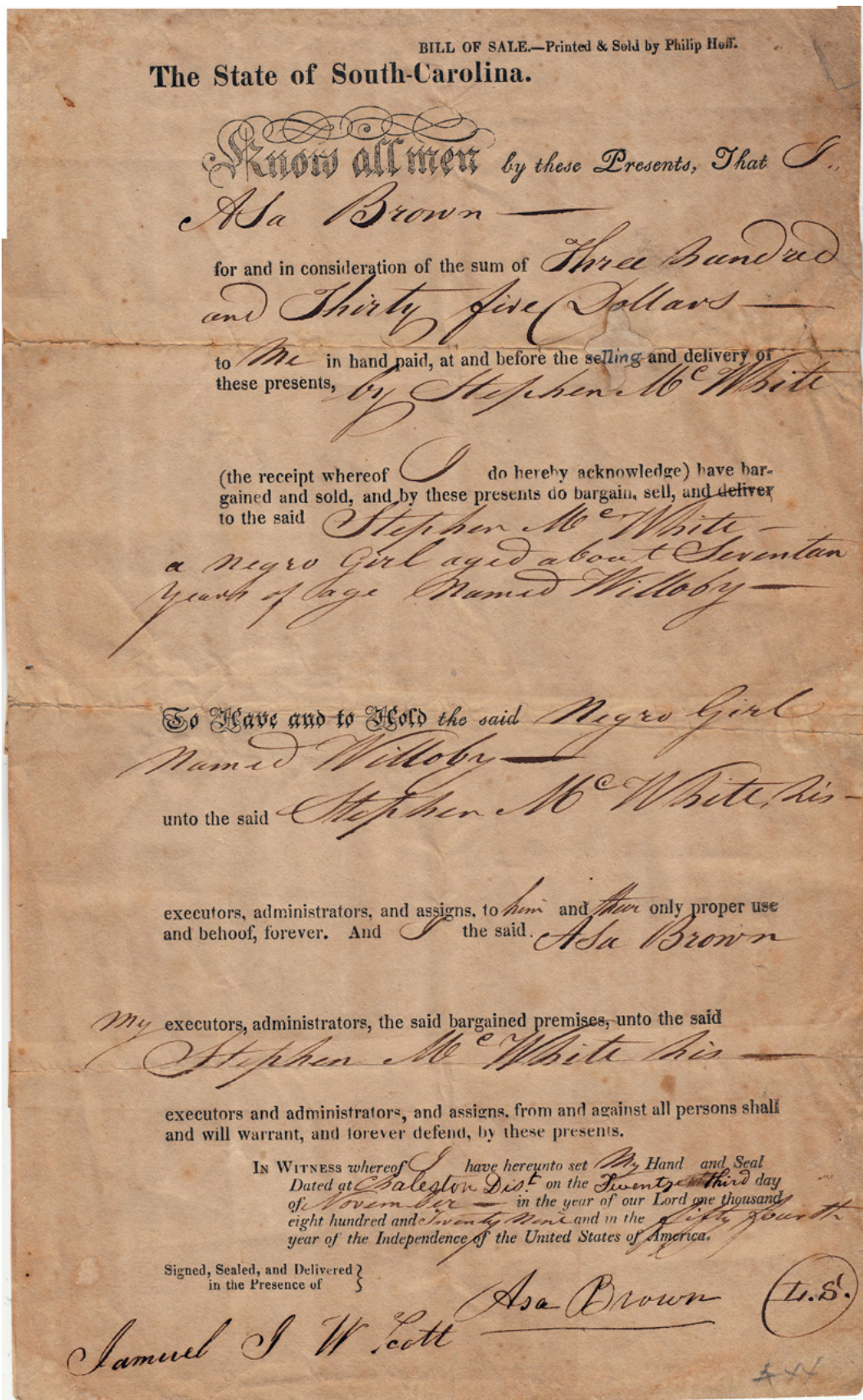

N^O 1. In the Name of God Amen I Stephen^C M White of South
Caroline & parish of S^t Stephen being low in health but of
sound mind and memory do make ordain and publish this instru-
ment of writing to be my last will & testament in manner and
form following. First I most humbly bequeath my soul to God
my maker, I give my body to the Earth from whence it came
was taken as to my worldly Estate I wish divided as follows.
After paying all just debts, First I give and bequeath to my
loving wife Mary Ann M White^C Three negroes viz Judy and her
two children Abram and Satira, also a riding chair and my bay
horse William, and one hundred Dollars in cash Second I give
and bequeath to my brother Lewis M White^C three negroes viz
Metto Moses & Fanny and my double barrel Gun. Third I give
and bequeath to my Sister Elizabeth M White^C three negroes
viz Lydia and her two children Rose and October, which I will
to her and her ifssue Fourth, I give and bequeath to my bro-
ther John M White^C one young fellow named Six. Fifth I give
and bequeath to my sister Mary Daniels one negro woman named
Willoughby, which I will to her and her ifssue. Sixth I give
and bequeath to my brother Joshua M White^C my tract of Land
situated in the above said State & parish on Murray's Ferry
road. Seventh. I wish all my remaining negroes which are six
in number viz Monday, Mingoe Betty, Lisette, Patty and Cain
with all the rest of my personal property to be sold and all
just demands to be paid which are against my estate. It is
also my wish that what money is left from paying my debts
shall be put on interest which Interest alone to be given to
my father Joshua M White^C for a support during his life. It
is my wish that Arnold J. Harvey and Lewis M^C White may be Exe-
cutors to this my last Will and testament In witnefs whereof

Pursuant to a writ of Partition to us directed by
E. B. Wheeler Esq., Ordinary of Marion District to di-
vide the property named in the 7th Item of the will of James
Daniels Decd, among the parties therein mentioned, we have
this day, after being duly sworn, discharged that duty, so
far as to the negro property (the other property having been
before sold) and report that the whole amount of appraise-
ment was, six thousand two hundred Dollars, making the
share of each heir \$1033.33 $\frac{1}{3}$ Dollars. James C. Daniels drew
the following negroes viz Willoby valued at 400 Dollars, Caroline at 300
Dollars, Gaston at 250 Dollars, Patty at 150 Dollars, making 1100 Dollars
being \$66.66 $\frac{2}{3}$ over his share, and he has to pay Mary Poston \$33.33 $\frac{1}{3}$
and Jane Daniels (now Jane Poston) \$33.33 $\frac{1}{3}$.

Mary Poston drew Lidia valued at 700 Dollars & Amanda at 300 = \$1000
Jane Daniels (now Jane Poston) drew Nelson valued at \$1000
Ann Daniels drew Tom valued at \$1000
Sarah Daniels (now Sarah Poston) drew Abose valued at \$1000
being \$33.33 $\frac{1}{3}$ less than the share of each of the last four named heirs
Martha Daniels drew Andrew valued at 400 Dollars Little
Lidia valued at 700 Dollars making \$1100, being \$66.66 $\frac{2}{3}$ over
her share and she pays to Ann Daniels \$33.33 $\frac{1}{3}$, and to Sarah
Daniels (now Sarah Poston) \$33.33 $\frac{1}{3}$. We have allotted to each
one of the heirs the negroes that they drew, as above stated.
